Most classes will be month-long offerings while others will last for 8 to 10 weeks.

Dance class on Thursdays is a year-long class.

Classes will meet from 11:10 a.m. until 12:45 p.m. or 1:15 p.m.

All are welcome — you do not need to be currently enrolled at First School to attend.

Class Schedule

OCTOBER: On Mondays through November 13 fellow parent, Courtney Adam will offer YOGA FOR PRESCHOOLERS.

Wednesdays we will continue our Soccer Shots class.

On Thursdays: Dance class with Mrs. Merrill. Your child will be introduced to a variety of dance disciplines such as ballet, jazz, hula, hip hop, etc. Performances given during class at Christmas and end of the year. No special clothes or shoes are required. A wonderful introduction to dance in a great low-key environment.

NOVEMBER: On Mondays Yoga for Preschoolers continues. On Tuesdays and Thursdays (both days for a total of four classes for the month) COOKING Class will teach the importance of following the directions of a recipe. Children will learn to add ingredients in a special 1, 2, 3 order. They will also learn about chemical reactions through experimenting with different recipes. Math will be highlighted through using different measurements.

DECEMBER: Holiday Crafts will be taught on Tuesdays and/or Wednesdays. Your child will make gifts for the special people in their lives.



January: Our Friends at the Stephen K. Hayes Quest Center will teach a four week Mighty Dragons Ninja class on Mondays and Wednesdays emphasizing skills which greatly enhance self-confidence and respect. On Tuesdays and Thursdays we will offer a Drama Class and Folk Tales class.

February: Look for a professionally taught rhythmic DRUM and MOVEMENT program de-



signed for whole-body and brain development. Healthy Cooking class and Jr. Builders, classes will also be offered.
