This class is immensely popular.



YOUNG 5's CLASS for 2021-22

We are offering a young 5's class for the 2021-22 school year. This class is designed for children who turn 5 in May through December. They may be eligible for kindergarten but may benefit from extra time to strengthen social and academic skills. The class will be a combination of large group, small group and individualized instruction for the children. Basic kindergarten skills will be introduced and strengthened throughout the year. Children will be able to learn at their own pace and skill level. Many different opportunities for academic, social and gross motor skills will be provided throughout the year. After completing this class the students will have a great foundation to move onto kindergarten. This class will be offered M-F AM with an option to extend the day until 2:15 with the addition of the afternoon enrichment session on MWF. We are also offering an Afternoon session of this class on MWF. Be sure to sign up early! We also will have PM Kindergarten from 11:30 to 2:15 Monday through Friday.
